



COVID 19 REOPENING

Northampton County Fire School will be reopening for onsite / in-person classes beginning July 2020.

Instructor, staff and student temperatures will be taken prior to entry to the classroom and acceptance into the scheduled course. Any individual having a temperature exceeding the CDC and DOH guidelines will not be permitted to attend class.

Social distancing is required and all participants must provide their own face mask.

All onsite classes will be limited to a maximum of 16 students.

All PPE, SCBAs etc. are to remain in your vehicle until such time that they are needed and are not to be brought into the classroom. Sharing of any PPE, SCBA etc. is not permitted.

The classroom, equipment and props used for training will be sanitized after each use. Individuals must provide their own lunch and snacks. Social distancing must be maintained during lunch and at break times.

Should any participant become ill during any training session a class wide email will be sent out notifying all students. Should this occur additional notifications will be made in accordance to CDC and DOH guidelines.

Class registrations appear to have stopped with the Governor's stay at home order issued in March.

There is a minimum requirement of 8 students being registered to hold classes. As of June 11, 2020 the Essentials program beginning July 23, 2020 does not have sufficient student registrations to hold the class.

Additional registrations are needed.

Level 1 – ELIS has 6 registered

Hazmat Awareness – HMAJB has 1 registered

Level 2 – ELFG has 6 registered

Level 3 – ELEF has 5 registered

Hazmat Operations – HMOJB has 1 registered

Level 4 – ELIF has 4 registered

If there are insufficient registrations by July 16th the essentials program will be canceled for Fall 2020
